## **Borealis Brass Trio** **University of Alaska Fairbanks**

Borealis Brass Trio was formed in 1994 to present performances of brass trio literature and to commission works for this idiom. The group is comprised of a trumpet, horn, and trombone. To date this ensemble has had brass trios commissioned by Frank Mantooth, Henry Wolking, Curt Olson, Elizabeth Raum, Erica Raum, Ann Callaway, Jeanne Shaffer, Gwyneth Walker, and Adriana I. Figueroa Mañas.

Since its creation Borealis Brass has performed throughout the State of Alaska as well as for state officials and governors. They have also performed at Alaska Music Educators state conventions, district music festivals and at summer music camps. The ensemble will perform at the Vatican's year 2000 celebration at a cathedral in Rome in December. The group is currently working on its first CD using original compositions for brass trio. Members of the group are University of Alaska Fairbanks faculty John Harbaugh, trumpet, Jane Aspnes, horn, and James Bicigo, trombone. They have performed as soloists and members of ensembles throughout the US, Canada, Japan, China, and Europe.
